Rainbow Mountain Pally Punchu hike Full Day

This rainbow mountain Pally Punchu is recently discovered and is known by the name “Apu Taclo”, it is located a few hours from the city of Cusco. Pally punchu is related to Andean clothing that is handmade, which is decorated with different colors, symbols and animal designs.

This geological formation of sharp rocks at whimsical angles combined with various colors similar to Vinicunca, leads us to imagine the multicolored Andean poncho of our mountains that our Peruvian brothers wear from above.

To do this, you will pass through the beautiful blue lagoon of Langui to walk for approximately two hours to the top. You will feel the privilege of appreciating the impressive views of the area while you travel along the perfect lines of the mountain with shades of cyan, brown and magenta. Plus, you'll learn about authentic Andean geology and traditions while surrounded by stunning mountains and red grasslands. Join us and don't forget to bring your Andean poncho to take the best photographs! Are you ready for the rainbow mountain pally punchu hike 1 day?

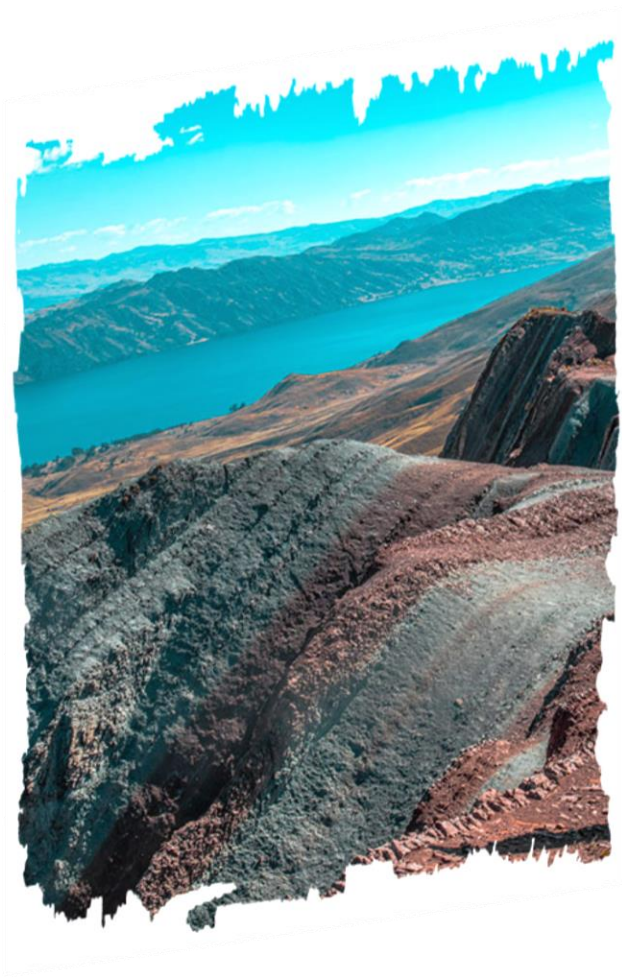

1**DAY**

Explore Pallay Punchu Hike 1 Day - Apu T'aclo



This fascinating adventure begins when we pick you up from your hotel early in the morning approx. 3.30 am. We will go by private bus two and a half hours away to Cusipata to have an energizing breakfast. Then we will continue along the road to Sicuani, enjoying along the way the beauty of the blue lagoon of Langui, which extends for more than 15 km. We will stop on the shore before continuing our way to Layo, where the walk begins.

Once there, we will begin this challenging uphill hike for approximately two hours. We will walk along a path that runs through grasslands and impressive red lands accompanied by typical fauna of the area: alpacas, llamas and, if we are lucky, kestrels, peregrine falcons or the famous condor flying overhead. When we arrive at the Pallay Punchu del Apu Taqlllo, which translated in Quechua means “woven poncho”, you will have the opportunity to climb the sharp edges of the mountain and feel like you are flying over the surface of another planet.

This mountain stands out for its precise lines, perfectly sculpted by nature over millions of years. You will be able to distinguish various colors such as red, brown, yellow, green, magenta and ocher, among others. While you enjoy the wonderful pigmentation of various shades, you can also read aloud from the edge to get an even better view of the impressive Langui lagoon and a part of the Andes mountain range.

You will reach an altitude of more than 4,600 m (15,100 ft). We will return to Layo along the same path. And we head towards Sicuani where we will have lunch and finally, we will return to Cusco to finish this amazing adventure pallay punchu hike 1 day.
